THE FREQUENCY

The frequency, regular and continuous, is prerequisite to ensure an optimal educational experience, as well as a proper functioning of the school.

Parents are responsible for informing the teachers in case of an absence, explaining the reason.

PARENT-TEACHER MEETINGS

Teachers periodically meet with parents in order to discuss the class syllabus, the children, their problems and progress. These meetings are important in order to enable the school and family to work together towards the child's education and integration in the school. Every teacher informs the parents of the day on which they can meet to talk about the child in an individual interview. The parents may also ask for an interview with the teachers.

CATHOLIC EDUCATION

Italian schools teach the Catholic religion for one hours per week. Upon registration, parents must declare whether they choose to:

Therefore at the time of enrolment the parent has to declare whether they intend for their child to have or not Catholic education.

If parents decide not to allow their children to receive Catholic education, they can choose between two possible alternatives:

- educational with the help of teaching staff

- leave the school.
